<u>Inclusion</u>	£18 000
Continued employment of a Speech and Language Therapist – many children enter school with very low communication skills. The Speech and Language Therapist works 1:1 or in small groups with children to increase their language skills. She also trains and offers support to staff and parents. In addition to this the therapist carries out Wellcomm screening, dyslexia screening and provides detailed reports for school, parents and external agencies as required	
Continued employment of counselling service from Caritas – the school employs the services of Caritas in the form of a Family Support Worker who works with children facing emotional and/or behavioural difficulties both in school and at home. Children receive high quality support in their one to one meetings with the FSW. He also visits the home and offers support to parents and other members of the family

Leasing of a school minibus to ensure learning in a real context

Subsidising of school trips, residentials and events to ensure access for all children

Extra curricular clubs – we offer a range of clubs such as art, music, Tales at Teatime, dance and movie night. There are clubs every night of the week allowing children to develop their social and communication skills in a fun, enjoyable and exciting environment

## Measuring the impact of PPG spending

In Year 6 - 57% of Pupil Premium children achieved the standard in reading, writing and maths combined and in reading, writing, maths and GPS separately. 14% achieved the higher standard in reading, maths and GPS.

In Year 2 - 50% of Pupil Premium children achieved the standard in reading and maths and 38% achieved the standard in writing.

Year 1 phonics – 91% of Pupil Premium children achieved the standard with an average mark of 36.5. In Year 2 – 88% of Pupil Premium children achieved the standard with an average mark of 33.4.

In Foundation 2 – 67% of Pupil Premium children achieved GLD and achieved expected in all areas.
