As we approach an extremely busy time in school, we thought it might be useful to pass on some of the dates we already have planned for this Christmas. It will be necessary to send further notifications out, but the following details are the earlier dates you need now:

### **Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> November – Parent Christmas Craft begins for 4 weeks 1.15pm-3.15pm**



This year we are doing it a bit differently to previous years. Instead of parents paying for the class and keeping what they have made, this year school will provide the resources and we will sell the items made before Christmas to go towards the cost of the Christmas Pantomime. All parents, grandparents, friends and parents of ex-pupils are welcome to attend, please contact the school office and let us know that you will be coming along – we usually have a great time!

### **Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> November – Adults Only – Christmas Shopping Trip to the Trafford Centre – 9.00am-3.15pm £3.00pp**

There are still a few seats available if you would like to join us on our Annual Christmas Shopping Trip. We provide the transport and then you are free to shop 'til you drop (or run out of money!). There are loads of shops and eateries at the Trafford Centre and we have a lovely, relaxed time. **Friday 18<sup>th</sup> November is Children In Need Day** – If children would like to join in our fundraising effort they can donate £1.00 to come to school dressed in spots like Pudsey himself or with a mad hairdo – this is not compulsory, children need only take part if they wish to. After assembly on Friday we will be holding a coffee morning and cake sale, to which all parents are invited. There will also be a number of other activities in class and at breaktime. Please allow your child to bring some spending money next Friday so they can help to raise money for Children in Need.
